## Easy Starters to Increase Choice in Your Classroom

$\square$ Realize that giving students choice might decrease behavior, increase motivation and teach life skills!Let students choose the content by creating a brainstorming list of topics students want to learn about.
$\square$ Allow student questions to drive topic exploration. Encourage their curiosity.
$\square$ Draw on students' differing strengths, abilities and interests!Involve students in choosing resources and materials.Provide options for HOW students will learn the content and HOW they will show their learning.
Choice boards are great for this!
$\square$ Put students in charge! Students can be "the resident expert" on topics as you work through units.
Better yet, make them the teacher!
$\square$ Make room in your day for Genius Hour or a Passion Project.

Consider flexible seating...although this isn't curricular, it does give students freedom and a chance to learn about what works best for them!
$\square$ Limit choices if students become overwhelmed and add them back in as students get more comfortable.
