To whom it may concern:

The purpose of this letter is to verify that all courses offered via Roosevelt University's partnership with Teaching Channel are designed specifically for graduate level continuing education to help educators stay current in their field and meet certification needs. Roosevelt University's Department of Education critically evaluates all Teaching Channel courses to make sure they meet our graduate level standards. Upon successful completion, the Continuing Education Credits earned through Teaching Channel courses are reflected on an official Roosevelt University transcript.

Please note that enrollment in these individual graduate level courses does not equate to enrollment in a graduate course at Roosevelt University. However, the courses that we offer through this partnership can be petitioned through a Prior Learning Assessment process to be accepted as part of a student's electives in a degree program if the student decides to pursue higher education at Roosevelt University. Two to three Teaching Channel courses can be bundled to constitute a three credit hour graduate course equivalent.

For example, a student may earn up to 9 (nine) credit hours via approved combinations of continuing education credits towards the following programs:

- MA in Literacy Leadership (30 credit hours total)
- MA in Secondary Ed (33 credit hours total)
- Interdisciplinary Studies EdD in Higher Ed Leadership (60 credit hours total, hybrid)
- Interdisciplinary Studies EdD in Organizational Leadership (60 credit hours total, hybrid)
