### ACADEMIC STANDARDS:

To remain in good academic standing, undergraduate students must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.0; graduate students must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.0.

### ACCREDITATION:

Greenville University has been accredited since 1947 by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools as a four-year bachelor's degree granting institution. In 1996, Greenville University received accreditation for granting the master's degree. Since 1974, the Illinois State Teacher Certification Board has approved the teacher education programs.

### COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT:

Students from the southwestern region of Illinois between the years of 1975 – 1997 had the option to participate in an articulation plan between Kaskaskia College and Greenville University. Students pursued their program of studies at Kaskaskia College by attending Greenville University. Students could take all course in the Greenville curriculum that are equivalent to courses in the Kaskaskia curriculum. Course titles ending with the letter K are courses students took as part of this agreement.

### McALLASTER SCHOLARS HONORS PROGRAM:

The honors program at Greenville University was established in 1995. The program consists of enriched sections of general education classes, notated with H in the course identification, and with special honors seminars. McAllaster Scholars must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5, and completed a Departmental Honors Thesis.

### OFF-CAMPUS STUDY:

Students who study abroad through approved Greenville University programs are considered in residence with regard to credit. However, grades earned are not reflected in the semester or cumulative grade point average.

### REPEATED COURSES:

When a course is repeated for credit, only the highest grade is calculated in determining the grade point average. However, all entries remain a part of the student's permanent record. Repeated courses are indicated by an R.

### TRANSFER CREDIT:

Credit earned at another accredited institution and accepted by Greenville University is recorded in semester hours. Grade values for courses completed at another institution are not indicated or calculated in the Greenville University GPA. More information on our transfer policies can be found on the University website.

### UNIVERSITY STATUS:

On June 1, 2017 Greenville College became Greenville University. Transcripts for students of Greenville College and Greenville University are printed on official Greenville University paper.
