

Create a new slides presentation in seconds

Need a new Slide deck? Just type "**slides.new**" into the omnibox (or web address bar) and a new blank Slide deck will open. Voilá!





Change the page size to suit your needs

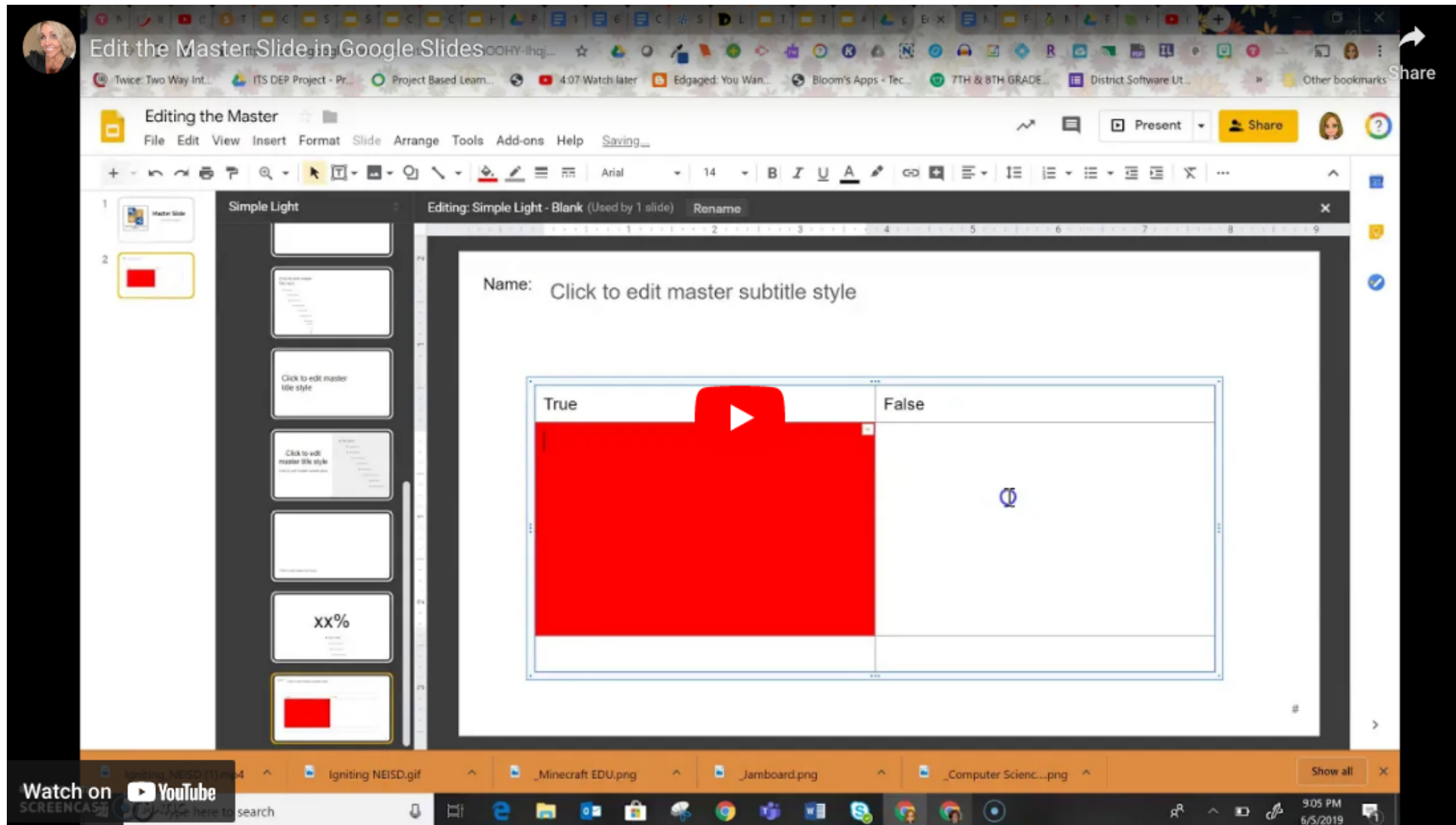
Customize the page size to 8.5 x 11 in. for ebooks and digital notebooks or larger for posters and infographics.




