Students can petition to amend up to six (6) credits of Teaching Channel with Learners Edge courses into our Master of Education in Educator Practices program at Southern New Hampshire University. Approval of the petition is determined by program leadership. Course Completion is documented with a letter grade on an official University transcript. Southern New Hampshire University is accredited by the New England Commission for Higher Education.
