

Al Integration Readiness Roadmap for K-12 Districts

A phased approach to responsible, equitable adoption.

Al in education offers tremendous promise, but it must be implemented with responsibility at every stage. Districts should ensure equitable access to devices, connectivity, and tools for all learners, especially in underserved communities, and monitor Al outputs for bias.




